

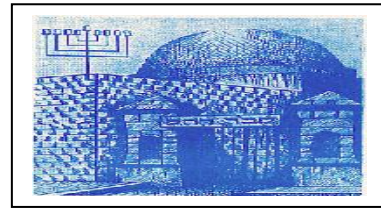

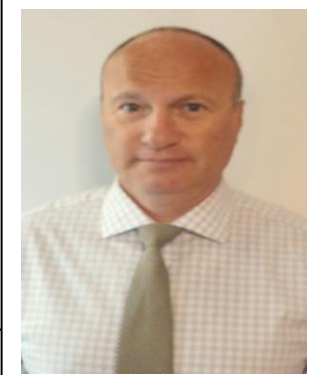

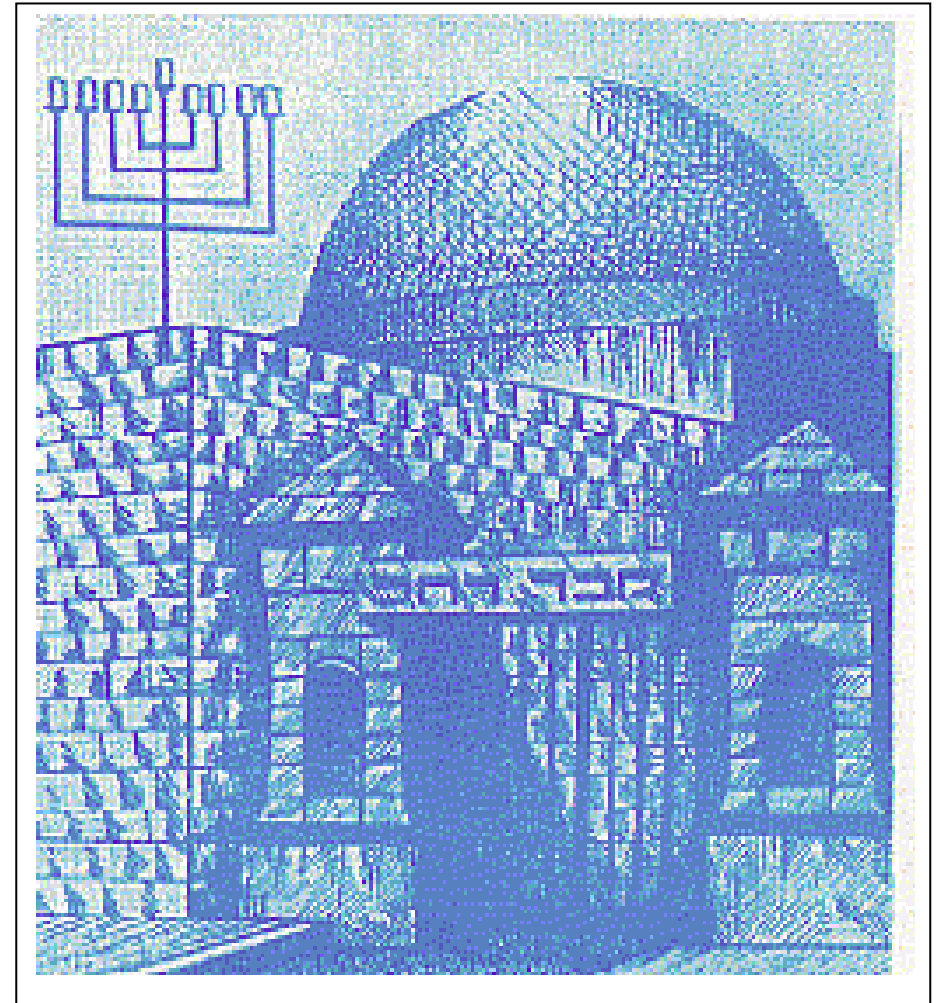

Sunday October 29, 2017 for the 23rd Rachels Children Reclamation Foundation dinner commemorating the Yahrzeit of Rachel Imeinu.

Please rush your reservations and ads to help the organization that brought a Sefer Torah to Rachel's Tomb Rosh Chodesh Tammuz 5758. This very successful event with thousands attending which caused Kever Rachel to become open 24 hours. RCRF saved the Egged Bus 163 increasing the ridership from 4 to 32 and then overflowing. RCRF dedicated a framed Shir HaShirim *klaf* which is on the wall in the men's section of Kever Rachel since 2003. RCRF petitions got 7 more buses. There are now 5, 8, 9, 10, 11am, 1, 3, 5, 7 pm daily Egged buses leaving on Jaffa Road across from the Jerusalem Central Station daily.

RCRF hosts shiurim in Kever Rachel as well as in the building Beit Bnei Rachel, the House of Rachel's Children purchased with all RCRF charity money in March 2001. A second RCRF Sefer Torah was dedicated in 2005. Hundreds crowded the dedication in our large Reception Center. RCRF housed about 60 IDF soldiers in the RCRF building from 2001 until the wall was completed in 2007.

A large weekly group from Efrat maintained lectures remembering Sara Blaustein, HYD who was with Evelyn when they first saw the building RCRF purchased site unseen, on Purim 2001. The soldiers knowing of the purchase led us onto the roof to a bullet proof glass security case. Evelyn placed her camera lens to the space for the rifle butt. Lunch and Learn, Tea and Torah programs, Hafraшат Challah as well as life cycle events are some of the many activities.

There was a Museum of Jewish Aliyah. The Biblical Art Museum last displayed the art works of Malla Carl, obm. RCRF dreams of building a RACHEL TEAR memorializing the victims of terrorism as well as a replica of Rachel's Tomb circa 1500 as a chuppah in our Biblical Garden. An architect is already working on the Rachel Tear as a Memorial monument. Help actualize the RCRF dreams. RCRF dreams are all Rachel's children's dreams.

Activist, **Dr. Paul Brody**, past recipient of the Rachel Imeinu Bonei Yisrael Award, is the Master of Ceremonies. **Rabbi Y. Y. Rubinstein** is the Keynote Speaker. The topic is "Shepherds and Sheep" inspired by the 23rd Psalm, "The Lord is My Shepherd." He will be introduced by Tiferet Levi, a past Young Leadership Awardee and Yaniv Meirov, Director of CHAZAQ. **Jack Doueck** author of "Chesed Bommerang" will receive the Rachel Imeinu Chesed Award. He tells with fantastic anecdotes that what we give comes back to us with blessings. He will be introduced by Mr. Richard Rudi, Esq. **Gershon Veroba** will receive the "Breaking the Silence Award." His original songs and powerful music not only have the beat but also beat for our Jewish heart and soul. **Alex Chernis** will receive the Community Service Award. He will be introduced by Angela Task. Our dearest **Francine Solomon**, OBM of Manhattan Beach, Five Towns and Boca Raton, Florida will be remembered by her daughter Carolyn Deutsch formerly of Manhattan Beach, Brooklyn, and now the Five Towns. Vivian Singer, president of the Sisterhood of Manhattan Beach Jewish Center will recognize the achievements of our MBJC past president.
